Member admonished

On 13 December 2007, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a member. The complaint that the member was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that, on 7 October 2003 at Birmingham Magistrates' Court he was convicted of soliciting women for the purpose of prostitution, contrary to Section 1 (1) of the Sexual Offences Act 1985, was found proved.

The Committee ordered that the member should be admonished, pay costs of £797.50, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press not referring to the member by name.
