Student removed from register

On 15 February 2007, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Mr Muhammad Ahsan Iqbal of Ammar Heights, Karachi, Pakistan. The complaint that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i), in that he failed to co-operate with ACCA investigating officers during the course of the investigation, namely that he failed to respond to requests for information, contrary to Regulation 3(3) of the Chartered Certified Accountants' Disciplinary Regulations 2001, was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Iqbal should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £100, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
