## **Students removed from register**

On 16 January 2007, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered two complaints against two students, Mr Neil Ashworth of International Business Park, Singapore and Mr Morten Jelert of 130 Tanjong Rhu Road, Pebble Bay, Singapore. The complaints that they was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that, when submitting a DA2 project report for the Diploma in Financial Management:

- i) Mr Ashworth obtained assistance by improper means by colluding with and/or copying from Mr Jelert, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity
- ii) Mr Jelert obtained assistance by improper means by colluding with and/or copying from Mr Ashworth, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity

were found proved.

The Committee ordered that both Mr Ashworth and Mr Jelert should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £375 each, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring them by name.
