## **Member severely reprimanded**

On 16 January 2007, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered two complaints against a member, Mr Paramjit Bhatti FCCA of Gower Street, Wolverhampton. The complaints that he was liable to disciplinary action, in that:

(i) (a) under bye-law 8(a)(i), he failed to co-operate with the Association in its monitoring and enforcement of compliance with the Global Practising Regulations and with the bye-laws, contrary to Regulation 14(3) of the Chartered Certified Accountants' Global Practising Regulations 2003

and

(b) under bye-law 8(a)(iii), he has committed a breach of Regulation 14(3) of the Chartered Certified Accountants' Global Practising Regulations 2003, by failing to co-operate with the Association in its monitoring and enforcement of compliance with the Global Practising Regulations and with the bye-laws

were found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Bhatti should be severely reprimanded, pay a fine of £2000 and costs of £902, and that the decision should be published by
