Students removed from register

On 17 April 2007, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered separate complaints against two students, Mr Chimenem Azunwena Chuku of Jalan Stampin Timur, Sarawak, Malaysia and Mr Gabriel Oguchukwu Okeke of Jalan Stampin Timur, Sarawak, Malaysia. The complaints that they were liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i), in that while sitting the ACCA Computer Based Examination for Paper 1.2, Financial Information Management:

- (i) Mr Chuku obtained assistance by improper means by switching seats with Mr Okeke during the examination in order to assist him in his examination attempt, contrary to Examination Regulations

and

- (ii) Mr Okeke obtained assistance by improper means by switching seats with Mr Chuku during the examination in order to assist him in his examination attempt, contrary to Examination Regulations

were found proved.



The Committee ordered that Mr Chuku and Mr Okeke should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £375 each, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to them by name.
