Students removed from register

On 17 April 2007, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered separate complaints against two students, Mr Umar Raza of Cave Street, Preston and Mr Muhammad Umar Shoaib of Dickenson Road, Manchester. The complaints that they were liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i), in that when submitting course work for Papers 1.1 and 1.2 for an internally assessed course run by a tuition provider:

- (i) Mr Raza obtained assistance by improper means from Mr Shoaib, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity;

and

- (ii) Mr Shoaib obtained assistance by improper means from Mr Raza, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity

were found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Raza and Mr Shoaib should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £375 each, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to them by name.
