## **Student removed from register**

On 26 April 2007, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Mr Bernard O'Connell of Kilteragh, Limerick. The complaint that Mr O'Connell was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i), in that whilst employed by a sporting club he wrote out to himself cheques belonging to the club, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity, was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr O'Connell should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £708 and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
