## **Student removed from register**

On 28 June 2007, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Ms Jennifer Rebecca McLaughlin of Woodlee, Londonderry. The complaint that she was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that, she obtained a financial advantage from her employer in 2004 and 2005 by overstating her expense claims, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity, was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Ms McLaughlin should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £1,157, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to her by name.
