## **Student removed from register**

On 8 May 2008, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered two allegations against a student, Mr Abdullah Halde of Katherine Road, London. The allegations that he was liable to disciplinary action in that:

### **Allegation 1**

Under bye-law 8(a)(i), he is guilty of misconduct, as he obtained exemptions from papers 1.1, 1.2, and 1.3 when he knew or ought to have known he was not entitled to such exemptions, since he had not passed year three of a B.Com (three year integrated degree course) in Commerce, contrary to Fundamental Principle of Integrity.

### **Allegation 2**

Under bye-law 8(a)(i), he is guilty of misconduct as he has failed to co-operate with the Investigating Officer.

and/or

Under bye-law 8(a)(iii), he had breached a regulation, by failing to co-operate with the Investigating Officer.



were found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Halde should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £610.00, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
