Student removed from register

On 12 June 2008, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered one allegation against a student, Mr Mohammad Yeasin of Haverstock Hill, London. The allegation that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that he took to his desk and/or possessed while at that desk, materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use them, in his exam attempt of paper 2.5 Financial Reporting, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity, was found proven.

The Committee ordered that the student should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £375.00 and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
