Student removed from register

On 15 January 2008, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered two complaints against a student, Mr Ahsan Saeed of Kot Fateh Jamel, Okara, Pakistan. The complaints that he was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that he:

- i) falsified his Board of Intermediate & Secondary Education, Lahore Provisional Result Intimation for 2005 by showing his date of birth to be 18 March 1989 when his actual date of birth is 18 March 1990,

and

- ii) disclosed this falsified date of birth to ACCA as being his correct date of birth when he submitted his student registration documents to ACCA Pakistan, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity,

were found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Saeed should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £806, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
