Student removed from register

On 20 March 2008, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered an allegation against a student, Miss Rosalind Dooley of Byrne Road, London. The allegation that she was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that she failed to co-operate with the investigating officer, in breach of Regulation 3(3)(a) of the Chartered Certified Accounts' Disciplinary Regulations (as applicable in 2001) was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Miss Dooley should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £450.50, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to her by name.
