## **Student removed from register**

On 20 March 2008, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered two allegations against a student Ms Selestine Nsipa Ngelezi (also known as Ngelezi Mulenga) of Lusaka, Zambia. The allegations that she was liable to disciplinary action in that:

- i) under bye-law 8(a)(i) she is guilty of misconduct in that she falsified documents and misappropriated a firm's funds amounting to K17,783,000 (approx 2,200 GBP) contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity (as applicable in 2006),

and

- ii) under bye-law 8(a)(i) she is guilty of misconduct in that she failed to co-operate with the investigating officer, in breach of Regulation 3(3)(a) of the Chartered Certified Accounts' Disciplinary Regulations (as applicable in 2001),

were found proved.

The Committee ordered that Ms Ngelezi should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £485.50, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to her by name.
