Student removed from register

On 28 February 2008, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered two complaints against a student, Mr Mamun Ahmed of Mirpur Road, Dhaka, Bangladesh. The complaints that he was liable to disciplinary action in that:

- (a) under bye-law 8(a)(i) he is guilty of misconduct in that he failed to behave with integrity, contrary to the Fundamental Principle 5 of the Rulebook (as applicable in 2006) by fraudulently misappropriated a cheque made payable to and belonging to a company

and/or

- (b) under bye-law 8(a)(iii) he breached Fundamental Principle 5 of the Rulebook (as applicable in 2006) by fraudulently misappropriated a cheque made payable to and belonging to a company

were found proved.

The Committee ordered that Mr Ahmed should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £820, and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to him by name.
