Student removed from register

On 29 January 2008, the Disciplinary Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) considered a complaint against a student, Miss Nellie Ni Jia of Chaoyang District, Beijing, China. The complaint that she was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) in that she took to her desk and/or possessed while at that desk, materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use them, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity, was found proved.

The Committee ordered that Miss Ni Jia should be removed from the student register, pay costs of £610 and that the decision should be published by issuing a press release to the professional, national and local press referring to her by name.
