

# press release

A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 10.00 am Tuesday 1 July 2008, at Kingsway Hall Hotel, 66 Great Queen Street, London WC2B 5BX. The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wish to attend.

Two cases will be heard on this day:

**CASE 1** Concerns a member who is alleged to be liable to disciplinary action in that he has performed his professional work or conducted his practice improperly, inefficiently or incompetently to such an extent or on such a number of occasions as to bring discredit to himself and to the Association, contrary to Fundamental Principles of the Rules of Professional Conduct. The member is also alleged to be guilty of misconduct in that he failed to co-operate with the investigating officer during the course of the investigation contrary to Disciplinary Regulation.

**CASE 2** Concerns a student who is alleged to be guilty of misconduct by providing ACCA or one of its partners with false information and a false status report, both of which she knew to be false or did not believe to be true contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity. The student is also alleged to be guilty of misconduct in that she failed to co-operate with the investigating officer in the course of the investigation contrary to Disciplinary Regulation.

The cases will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Disciplinary Committee.
