A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 10.00 am Tuesday 3 June 2008, at ACCA, 29 Lincoln's Inn Fields, London WC2A 3EE. The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wish to attend.

Three cases will be heard on this day:

- CASE 1 Concerns a student who is alleged to be guilty of misconduct in that he took to his desk and/or possessed while at that desk, materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use them, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity
- CASE 2 Concerns a student who is alleged to be guilty of misconduct by failing to disclose his criminal conviction, and falsely representing that he had no previous convictions, when registering as a student of ACCA, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity
- CASE 3 Concerns a student who is alleged to be guilty of misconduct in that he submitted false documentation to the Home Office, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity

The cases will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Disciplinary Committee.
