A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 10.00 am on Tuesday 5 August 2008, at the Competition Appeal Tribunal, Victoria House, Bloomsbury Place, London, WC1A 2EB. The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wishes to attend.

Two cases will be heard on this day:

CASE 1 Concerns a student who is alleged to be guilty of misconduct by providing ACCA or one of its partners with false information and a false status report contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity. And who also failed to co operate with the investigating officer during the course of the investigation.

CASE 2 Concerns a student who is alleged to be guilty of misconduct in that she took to her desk and/or possessed while at that desk, materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use them contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity.

The cases will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Disciplinary Committee.
