A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 10.00 am on Thursday 7 August 2008, at the Competition Appeal Tribunal, Victoria House, Bloomsbury Place, London, WC1A 2EB. The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wishes to attend.

Three cases will be heard on this day:

CASE 1 Concerns an allegation that a student engaged in unprofessional conduct designed to assist him in his examination attempt contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity.

CASE 2 Concerns an allegation that a student submitted false documentation to the Home Office contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity.

CASE 3 Concerns an allegation that a student took to her desk and/or possessed while at that desk, materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use them in her exam attempt contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity.

The cases will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Disciplinary Committee.
