A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 10.00 am Thursday 8 May 2008, at ACCA, 29 Lincoln's Inn Fields, London WC2A 3EE. The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wishes to attend.

Three cases will be heard on this day:

- CASE 1 Concerns a student who is alleged to be guilty of misconduct in that he was convicted of having stolen a birth certificate in his possession, for use in the course of or in connection with a fraud.
- CASE 2 Concerns a student who is alleged to be guilty of misconduct in that he obtained exemption from papers when he knew or ought to have known he was not entitled to such exemptions, contrary to the fundamental principle of Integrity, and failed to co-operate with the Investigating Officer.
- CASE 3 Concerns a member who is alleged to be liable to disciplinary action in that he received a disqualification order restricting him from being a director or taking part directly or indirectly in the management of any listed corporation, its subsidiaries or affiliates for a period of four years.

The cases will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Disciplinary Committee.
