A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 10.00 am Tuesday 8 July 2008, at Competition Appeal Tribunal, Victoria House, Bloomsbury Place, London WC1A 2EB. The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wish to attend.

Two cases will be heard on this day:

- CASE 1 Concerns a member who is alleged to be liable to disciplinary action in that he was convicted on indictment of conspiracy to defraud by the Crown Court.
- CASE 2 Concerns a student who is alleged to be guilty of misconduct in that he took to his desk and/or possessed while at that desk, materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use them contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity.

The cases will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Disciplinary Committee.
