

# press release

A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 10.00 am on 8 October 2008, at the Competition Appeal Tribunal, Victoria House, Bloomsbury Place, London, WC1A 2EB. The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wishes to attend.

Two cases will be heard on this day:

CASE 1        Concerns an allegation that a student is guilty of misconduct by providing ACCA with a medical certificate which he knew to be false or did not believe to be true in order to support an application for deferral, contrary to the fundamental principle of Integrity.

CASE 2        Concerns two allegations that a student is guilty of misconduct in that she was found guilty of theft and obtaining a money transfer by deception, and failed to inform ACCA of her conviction.

The cases will be heard by a panel of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee.
