A hearing of ACCA's Admissions and Licensing Committee will take place at 10.00 am on 9 September 2008, at The Competition Appeal Tribunal, Victoria House, Bloomsbury Place, London, WC1A 2EB. The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wishes to attend.

Seven matters will be heard on this day:

- CASE 1 Concerns an unsatisfactory outcome to a Committee ordered audit monitoring visit.
- CASE 2 Concerns an application for a rule waiver request for eligibility for a practising certificate.
- CASE 3 Concerns a member's eligibility for a practising certificate.
- CASE 4 Concerns a proposal to delegate authority to ACCA to allow it to vary the requirements of the Chartered Certified Accountants' Membership Regulation (MR) 4(4)(c)(i) in respect of continuing professional development.
- CASE 5 Concerns a claim for compensation under the Chartered Certified Accountant's Financial Services Compensation Regulations 1996 relating to the miss selling of an endowment policy.
- CASE 6 Concerns a claim for compensation under the Chartered Certified Accountant's Financial Services Compensation Regulations 1996 relating to the miss selling of an endowment policy.

CASE 7 Concerns a claim for compensation under the Chartered Certified Accountant's Financial Services Compensation Regulations 1996 relating to the miss selling of an endowment policy.
