A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 11.30 am on 9 October 2008, at The Chartered Institute of Arbitrators, 12 Bloomsbury Square, London WC1A 2LP. The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wishes to attend.

Two cases will be heard on this day:

CASE 1        Concerns three allegations that a member performed his professional work or conducted his practice, improperly, inefficiently or incompetently to such an extent or on such a number of occasions as to bring discredit to himself, to the Association or to the accountancy profession.

CASE 2        Concerns an allegation that a member is guilty of misconduct in that he was convicted of four counts of false accounting.

The cases will be heard by a panel of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee.
