A hearing of ACCA's Appeal Committee will take place at 10.00 am on Thursday 10 July 2008, at Competition Appeal Tribunal, Victoria House, Bloomsbury Place, London WC1A 2EB. The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wishes to attend.

Two cases will be heard on this day:

CASE 1 Is an appeal from the Disciplinary Committee concerning six allegations of a member who is guilty of misconduct, performed his professional work or conducted his practice improperly, inefficiently or incompetently to such an extent or on such a number of occasions as to bring discredit to himself and to the Association, and committed a breach of regulations.

CASE 2 Is an appeal from the Admissions & Licensing Committee concerning a member's rejected application for continuing membership following bankruptcy.

The cases will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Appeal Committee.
