A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 10.00 am Thursday 12 June 2008, at ACCA, 29 Lincoln's Inn Fields, London WC2A 3EE. The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wish to attend.

Three cases will be heard on this day:

- CASE 1 Concerns a student who is alleged to be guilty of misconduct in that he engaged in unprofessional conduct designed to assist him in his examination attempt, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity

- CASE 2 Concerns a student who is alleged to be guilty of misconduct in that he took to his desk and/or possessed while at that desk, materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use them, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity

- CASE 3 Concerns two students who are alleged to be guilty of misconduct in that acting jointly or separately they assisted and/or obtained assistance from the other by improper means during an exam contrary to Examination Regulations and the Fundamental Principle of Integrity

The cases will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Disciplinary Committee.
