A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 10.00 am Wednesday 16th April 2008, at ACCA, 29 Lincoln's Inn Fields, London WC2A 3EE. The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wishes to attend.

Four cases will be heard on this day:

- CASE 1 Concerns a member who has been disciplined by another professional body.
- CASE 2 Concerns a student who is alleged to be guilty of misconduct in that he took to his desk and or/possessed while at the desk materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use it, contrary to the fundamental principle of Integrity.
- CASE 3 Concerns a student who is alleged to be guilty of misconduct, in that he took to his desk and or/possessed while at the desk materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use it contrary to the fundamental principle of Integrity.
- CASE 4 Concerns a student who is alleged to be guilty of misconduct, in that she took to her desk and or/possessed while at the desk materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use it contrary to the fundamental principle of Integrity.

The cases will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Disciplinary Committee.
