

# press release

A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 10.00 am Thursday 17 July 2008, at The Lincoln Centre, 18 Lincoln's Inn Fields, London WC2A 3ED. The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wish to attend.

Four cases will be heard on this day:

- CASE 1        Concerns a student who is alleged to be guilty of misconduct in that he took to his desk and/or possessed while at that desk, materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use it, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity.
- CASE 2        Concerns a student who is alleged to be guilty of misconduct in that he took to his desk and/or possessed while at that desk, materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use them contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity.
- CASE 3        Concerns a student who is alleged to be guilty of misconduct in that he took to his desk and/or possessed while at that desk, materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use them contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity.
- CASE 4        Concerns a member who is alleged to be guilty of misconduct in that he was restricted by the Secretary for Trade and Industry, on the basis of a disqualification undertaking, from acting as a director of a company or an insolvency practitioner for a period of six years pursuant to section 1A of the Company Directors Disqualification Act 1986. The member is also alleged to be guilty of misconduct and committed a breach in that he failed to inform ACCA of his disqualification undertaking.
