A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 10.00 am on Wednesday 17 September 2008, at the Competition Appeal Tribunal, Victoria House, Bloomsbury Place, London, WC1A 2EB. The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wishes to attend.

Two cases will be heard on this day:

CASE 1 Concerns an allegation of that a student used unauthorised notes to gain an unfair advantage during the course of an examination contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity.

CASE 2 Concerns an allegation that Student A and Student B obtained or attempted to obtain an unfair advantage in a project submitted to ACCA by colluding in their answers contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity.

The cases will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Disciplinary Committee.
