A hearing of ACCA's Appeal Committee will take place at 10.00 am on Wednesday 18 June 2008, at ACCA, 29 Lincoln's Inn Fields, London WC2A 3EE. The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wishes to attend.

Three cases will be heard on this day:

CASE 1 Is an appeal from the Disciplinary Committee concerning one allegation of a member who pleaded guilty to false accounting at a Crown Court.

CASE 2 Is an appeal from the Disciplinary Committee concerning one allegation of a member who provided ACCA with a false statement of exam results.

CASE 3 Is an appeal from the Disciplinary Committee concerning six allegations that a member provided false and inaccurate information on his company website; breached the regulations governing advertising, publicity, and obtaining of professional work; attempted to induce the complainant to withdraw his complaint by threat; carried on public practice, without holding a practising certificate.

The cases will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Appeal Committee.
