

# press release

A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 11.00 am Tuesday 22 April 2008, at ACCA, 29 Lincoln's Inn Fields, London WC2A 3EE. The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wishes to attend.

Two cases will be heard on this day:

**CASE 1**        Concerns a student who is alleged to be guilty of misconduct in that she took to her desk and possessed while at that desk, materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use it contrary to the fundamental principle of Integrity.

**CASE 2**        Concerns a member who is alleged to be liable to disciplinary action in that she is guilty of misconduct and committed a breach of regulations by sending emails containing confidential and sensitive client information to a third party, contrary to the fundamental principle of Confidentiality.

The cases will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Disciplinary Committee.
