A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 10.00 am Wednesday 23 April 2008, at The Competition Appeal Tribunal, Victoria House, Southampton Row, London, WC1. The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wishes to attend.

Three cases will be heard on this day:

CASE 1 Concerns a student who is alleged to be guilty of misconduct in that he took to his desk and/or possessed while at that desk, materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use them, contrary to the fundamental principle of Integrity.

CASE 2 Concerns a student who is alleged to be guilty of misconduct in that she took to her desk and/or possessed while at that desk, materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use them, contrary to the fundamental principle of Integrity.

CASE 3 Concerns a student who is alleged to be guilty of misconduct in that she took to her desk and/or possessed while at that desk, materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use them, contrary to the fundamental principle of Integrity.

The cases will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Disciplinary Committee.
