

# press release

A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 10.00 am on Wednesday 24 September 2008, at the Competition Appeal Tribunal, Victoria House, Bloomsbury Place, London. WC1A 2EB. The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wishes to attend.

Four cases will be heard on this day:

- CASE 1        Concerns an allegation that a student took to his desk and/or possessed at that desk, or otherwise during the course of the examination, materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use them, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity.
- CASE 2        Concerns two allegations that a student attempted to obtain exemptions from papers by submitting falsified qualifications and failed to co-operate with the Investigating Officer.
- CASE 3        Concerns an allegation that a student provided ACCA with a medical certificate which he knew to be false or did not believe to be true in order to support an application for a deferral of an examination sitting.
- CASE 4        Concerns an allegation that a student took to her desk and/or possessed at that desk, or otherwise during the course of the examination, materials not authorised by the Registrar and intended to use them, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity.
