A hearing of ACCA's Disciplinary Committee will take place at 10.00 am Thursday 26 June 2008, at ACCA, 29 Lincoln's Inn Fields, London WC2A 3EE. The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wish to attend.

Three cases will be heard on this day:

- CASE 1 Concerns a member who is alleged to be guilty of misconduct in that he carried on public practice without a practising certificate, contrary to Global Practising Regulations and failed to co-operate with the investigating officer
- CASE 2 Concerns a student who is alleged to be guilty of misconduct by providing both ACCA and her former employer with false information and a false status report, both of which she knew to be false or did not believe to be true, contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity
- CASE 3 Concerns two students who are alleged to be guilty of misconduct in that during an examination they obtained assistance from and/or assisted the other by improper means contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity

The cases will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Disciplinary Committee.
