

# press release

A hearing of ACCA's Appeal Committee will take place at 10.00 am on 26 August 2008, at Competition Appeal Tribunal, Victoria House, Bloomsbury Place, London, WC1A 2EB . The hearing is open to any member of the public or the media who wishes to attend.

Three cases will be heard on this day:

CASE 1        Is an appeal from the Disciplinary Committee concerning one allegation of a member who is guilty of misconduct, in that he was disqualified from preparing and submitting Accountant's Reports to The Law Society on behalf of solicitors, pursuant to The Law Society's disciplinary process.

CASE 2        Is an appeal from the Disciplinary Committee concerning one allegation of a member who is guilty of misconduct, in that he performed his professional work improperly, inefficiently or incompetently to such an extent or on such number of occasions as to bring discredit to himself, to the Association or to the accountancy profession in that he failed to promptly provide transfer information.

CASE 3        Is an appeal from the Disciplinary Committee concerning one allegation of a member who is guilty of misconduct, in that she took without authority the sum of £16,068.00 from her employer contrary to the Fundamental Principle of Integrity.

The cases will be heard by a panel of the ACCA's Appeal Committee.
