Mr Christodoulos Papas

Christodoulos Papas is the recent past President of the Institute of Certified Public Accountants of Cyprus (ICPAC). His two-year term as President has been the apotheosis of his work for ICPAC, which has lasted over a decade.

One of the most significant achievements for ICPAC in the last ten years was receiving Recognised Supervisory Body status in 2002. Christodoulos was one of three members of the ICPAC Council sub-committee which was in charge of bringing this to fruition. Since achieving RSB status, the development and growth of the profession in Cyprus has been substantial.

Christodoulos is also a member of ACCA's International Assembly. He has used his dual roles to develop and strengthen links between ICPAC and ACCA, leading to extensive and close co-operation, including ACCA's Joint Examination Scheme, CPD scheme and audit monitoring and ICPAC quality checked systems for practising firms.
