Member severely reprimanded*

On 18 February 2019, the Consent Orders Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) found proved the following allegation against a member Mr Patrick Bermingham from Dublin, County Dublin, Republic of Ireland.

Allegation 1

Pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(vi), Mr Bermingham is liable to disciplinary action by virtue of the disciplinary finding against him on 30 May 2018 by the Disciplinary Committee of the Institute of Certified Public Accountants in Ireland ("CPA").

The Consent Orders Committee ordered that Mr Bermingham be given a severe reprimand, and pay costs to ACCA in the sum £4,128.50.

ACCA's regulations require ACCA to publish the Committee's finding and orders by way of a press release, as soon as practicable.
