Member has conditions placed on any future application for a practising certificate with audit qualification*

On 18 June 2019, the Admissions and Licensing Committee of ACCA (the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) considered a case concerning Mr A.

The Admissions and Licensing Committee made an order under their powers pursuant to Authorisation Regulation 6(16)(a)(v), that Mr A:

- a. had provided an action plan, which ACCA regards as satisfactory, setting out how he intends to prevent any recurrence of the serious failures in auditing practice;
- b. attended a practical audit course, approved by ACCA; and
- c. following the date of the Committee's order, passed the advanced level audit paper of ACCA's professional qualification.

Please note that this may be the subject of an appeal.

ACCA's regulations require ACCA to publish the Committee's findings and orders by way of a news release, as soon as practicable.
