Order made pursuant to Authorisation Regulations 5(2)(f) and 6(16)*

On 03 September 2019, the Admissions and Licensing Committee of ACCA (the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) considered a case concerning Person A and Person B, of Firm A:

The Admissions and Licensing Committee made an order pursuant to 5(2)(f) and 6(16) that any future application from Person A, or a firm in which he is principle, for audit qualification must be referred to the Admissions and Licensing Committee, which will not consider the application until he has, following the date of this order, attended a practical audit course approved by ACCA, and passed paper P7 (or the equivalent level audit paper) of ACCA's professional qualification.

The Committee made this order with immediate effect.

The Committee made no order in respect of Person B.

Please note that this may be the subject of an appeal.

ACCA's regulations require ACCA to publish the Committee's findings and orders by way of a news release, as soon as practicable.
