## Disciplinary Committee ordered Removal from Student Register\*

On 12 September 2019, the Disciplinary Committee of ACCA (the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) found proved the following allegations against Miss Dongyi Li of Kowloon, Hong Kong SAR:

- 1(a) During a Strategic Business Reporting examination on 6 December 2018 in Hong Kong, Miss Dongyi Li was in possession of unauthorised materials, namely a revision note, which she had at her desk, contrary to Examination Regulations 4 and 5.
- 1(b)Miss Dongyi Li intended and further attempted to use any or all of the unauthorised materials set out at 1(a) above to gain an unfair advantage.
- 1(c) Miss Dongyi Li's conduct in respect of 1(b) above was:
  - (i) dishonest, in that Miss Dongyi Li intended and attempted to use any or all of the unauthorised materials which she had at her desk to gain an unfair advantage
- 1(d)By reason of her conduct, Miss Dongyi Li is:
  - (i) guilty of misconduct pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(i), in respect of any or all of the matters set out at 1(a) to 1(c) above

The Disciplinary Committee ordered that Miss Dongyi Li be removed from the student register, and disqualified from the Strategic Business Reporting examination taken on 06 December 2018. The Committee further ordered Miss Dongy Li to pay costs to ACCA in the sum of £4,000.00.

Please note that this may be the subject of an appeal.

\* An order made by the Disciplinary Committee shall take effect from the date of expiry of the Appeal Period referred to in the Appeal Regulations unless the Committee directs that the order should have immediate effect
