Members auditing certificate withdrawn*

On Monday, 03 February 2020, the Admissions and Licensing Committee of ACCA (the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) considered a case concerning Mr Francis Arthur.

The Admissions and Licensing Committee made an order pursuant to 5(2)(f) of the Authorisation Regulations that his practising certificate and audit qualification be withdrawn and replaced with a practising certificate, and the auditing certificates of his firms Sam Dee & Co, Arthur Godsons & Associates, Platinum London Accounting Limited and Sami Francis & Co Accountants Ltd be withdrawn with immediate effect.

Any future re-application for audit registration by Mr Arthur, or a firm in which he is principal, must be referred to the Admissions and Licensing Committee, which will not consider the application until he has provided an action plan, attended a practical audit course, and passed paper P7 (or the equivalent advanced level audit paper) of the ACCA's professional qualification.


Please note that this may be the subject of an appeal.
