## Disciplinary Committee ordered Removal from the student register\*

On 08 October 2020, the Disciplinary Committee of ACCA (the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) found proved the following allegations against Miss Weng Jiang of Jingdezhen, Peoples' Republic of China:

### Allegation 1

- 1.1. Contrary to Paragraph 3(1) of the Complaints and Disciplinary Regulations 2014, Miss Jiang has failed to co-operate fully with the investigation of a complaint in that:
  - 1.2. She failed to respond at all to any to all of ACCA's correspondence dated:
    - 1.2.1. 06 November 2019;
    - 1.2.2. 28 November 2019;
    - 1.2.3. 13 December 2019;
  - 1.3 By reason of her conduct in respect of any or all of the matters set out at 1.1 and 1.2 above, Miss Jiang is:
    - 1.3.1 Guilty of misconduct, pursuant to byelaw 8(a)(i); or in the alternative
    - 1.3.2 In breach of byelaw 8(a)(iii)

The Disciplinary Committee ordered that Miss Weng Jiang be removed from the student register and to pay costs to ACCA in the sum of £5000.00.
