# Disciplinary Committee ordered Removal from Student Register\*

On 23 February 2021, the Disciplinary Committee of ACCA (the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) found proved the following allegations against Mr Yimin Ye, of Linhai, China:

### Allegation 1

- 1) During a Taxation UK examination on 03 December 2019, Mr Yimin Ye:
  - Was in possession of unauthorised material, namely notes, contrary to Examination a) Regulation 4;
  - Used or intended to use unauthorised material to gain an unfair advantage, contrary b) to Examination Regulations 6 and 11;
  - Engaged in improper conduct designed to assist him in his exam attempt contrary to c) Examination Regulation 9.
- 2) Mr Yimin Ye's conduct at Allegation 1(a), (b) and/or (c) was:
  - Dishonest, in that he used or intended to use unauthorised material to gain an unfair a) advantage in an examination;
- 3) By reason of his conduct Mr Yimin Ye is:
  - a) Guilty of misconduct pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(i), in respect of any or all of the matters set out at Allegations 1 and/or 2;

The Disciplinary Committee ordered that Mr Yimin Ye be removed from student register and to pay costs to ACCA in the sum of £6.500
