Members auditing certificate withdrawn*

On 19 January 2021, the Admissions and Licensing Committee of ACCA (the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) considered a case concerning Mr Kojo Amoah-Arko FCCA.

The Committee made an order pursuant to Authorisation Regulation 6(15) that:

- The auditing certificate for the Firm and Mr Amoah-Arko's practising certificate with audit qualification be withdrawn.
- Mr Amoah-Arko be re-issued with a practising certificate.
- Any future re-application for audit registration by Mr Amoah-Arko, or by a firm in which he is a principal, must be referred to the Admissions and Licensing Committee, which will not consider the application until he has provided an action plan, which ACCA regards as satisfactory, setting out how Mr Amoah-Arko intends to prevent a recurrence of the previous deficiencies and attended a practical audit course, approved by ACCA and, following the date of this order, passed the advanced audit and assurance paper of ACCA's professional qualification.

In accordance with PS13.1 the Committee was satisfied that it was necessary in order to protect the public to direct that its order have immediate effect.

Please note that this may be the subject of an appeal.
