Disciplinary Committee ordered Student be removed from register*

On 18 November 2021, the Disciplinary Committee of ACCA (the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) found proved the following allegations against Mr Penghui Zhang of Nanjing, China, Peoples Reps of:

Allegation 1

- During a Financial Reporting (FR) examination on 16 July 2020, Mr Penghui Zhang was in (a) possession of:
 - (i) Unauthorised materials in the form of two handwritten notes, contrary to Examination Regulations 4.
- Mr Penghui Zhang intended and/or additionally attempted to use those either or both notes set out (b) at 1(a) above to gain an unfair advantage.
- (c) Mr Penghui Zhang's conduct in respect of 1(b) above was:
 - (i) Dishonest, in that Mr Penghui Zhang intended and/or additionally attempted to use either or both the notes set out at 1(a) above to gain an unfair advantage.
