## Member Severely Reprimanded\*

On 20 April 2022, the Consent Orders Chair of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) found proved the following allegation against a member Mr Tong Yat Hung from Kowloon Bay, Hong Kong:

# Allegation:

1. Pursuant to byelaw 8(a)(vi) Mr Tong Yat Hung is liable to disciplinary action by virtue of action taken against him on 08 June 2020 by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants (HKICPA).

The Consent Orders Chair ordered that Mr Tong Yat Hung be severely reprimanded and pay costs to ACCA in thesum of £650.00.

ACCA's regulations require ACCA to publish the Chair's finding and orders by way of a press release, as soon as practicable.
