## Disciplinary Committee ordered removal from student register\*

On 16 December 2022, the Disciplinary Committee of ACCA (the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) found proved the following allegations against Mr Muhammad Saad, of Islamabad, Swabi, Pakistan:

## **Allegations**

Mr Muhammad Saad a student member of ACCA:

- On 20 February 2021, during a remotely invigilated FFA Financial Accounting examination (the Exam), 1) Mr Saad caused or permitted a third party to be present with him during all or part of the Exam, thus failing to comply with instructions provided to him by ACCA before the Exam and contained in ACCA's 'Information Sheet for On-Demand CBE Students', that he should ensure he was in a room with no one else around him, contrary to Examination Regulation 2.
- 2) Contrary to Regulation 3(1) of the Complaints and Disciplinary Regulations 2014 (as amended and in force at the time), Mr Saad failed to co-operate with the investigation of a complaint, in that he did not respond fully to any or all of ACCA's correspondence dated:
  - 04 May 2021; a.
  - b. 01 June 2021;
  - 15 June 2021; c.
  - 22 September 2021; d.
  - 04 October 2021. e.

	a. Guilty of misconduct pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(i).
The Disciplinary Committee ordered that Mr Muhammad Saad be removed and to pay costs to ACCA in the sum of £5800.	
Pleas	se note that this may be the subject of an appeal.
