Disciplinary Committee ordered Student removal*

On 19 July 2022, the Disciplinary Committee of ACCA (the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) found proved the following allegations against Mr Lukmanul Hakkeem K P, of Palakkad, Kerala:

Allegations

Mr Lukmanul Hakkeem K P (Mr Hakkeem), an Association of Chartered Certified Accountants ('ACCA') student:

- Contrary to Regulation 3(1) of the Complaints and Disciplinary Regulations 2014(as amended), Mr Hakkeem 1) failed to co-operate with the investigation of a complaint, in that he did not respond fully to any or all of ACCA's correspondence dated:
 - 10 April 2021; a.
 - 04 May 2021; b.
 - c. 21 May 2021;
- 2) By reason of his conduct Mr Hakkeem is:
 - Guilty of misconduct pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(i); in respect of any or all of the matters set out at a. Allegation 1 above.

The Disciplinary Committee ordered that Mr Hakkeem be removed and to pay costs to ACCA in the sum of £5000.00.

Please note that this may be the subject of an appeal.
