Disciplinary Committee ordered student be severely reprimanded*

On 08 November 2022, the Disciplinary Committee of ACCA (the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) found proved the following allegations against Mr Haroon Miah, of Hyde, Chesire, United Kingdom:

Allegations

- 1. Mr. Haroon Miah ('Mr. Miah'), a registered student of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants ("ACCA"):
 - On 28 June 2013 was convicted of Conspiracy to assist unlawful immigration to a member state, (a) contrary to section 1(1) of the Criminal Law 1977 which is discreditable to ACCA and/or the accountancy profession.
 - By reason of his conduct at 1(a) above, he is liable to disciplinary action pursuant to bye-law (b) 8(a)(i).
- 2. Between 10 October 2018 to 3 December 2019, Mr. Miah failed to bring promptly to the attention of the ACCA that he may have become liable to disciplinary action by way of the Conviction set out at 1(a) above, contrary to bye-law 10(b).

The Disciplinary Committee ordered that Mr Haroon Miah be severely reprimanded and to pay costs to ACCA in the sum of £500.
