## Member severely reprimanded\*

On 27 September 2022 the Consent Orders Chair of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) found proved the following allegations against a member, Mr Chin Yoong Mun from Perai, Pulau Pinang, Malaysia:

### Allegation 1

Pursuant to byelaw 8(a)(vi), Mr Chin Yoong Mun is liable to disciplinary action by virtue of the disciplinary action taken against him by the Disciplinary Committee of the Malaysian Institute of Accountants ("MIA") on 30 March 2021.

### Allegation 2

- a) Mr Chin Yoong Mun failed to promptly bring to the attention of ACCA that he might have become liable to disciplinary action by reason of the disciplinary action taken against him by the MIA, contrary to byelaw 10(b).
- b) By reason of his conduct at 2(a) above, Mr Chin Yoong Mun is liable to disciplinary action pursuant to bye-law 8(a)(iii).

The Consent Orders Chair ordered that Mr Mun be severely reprimanded and pay costs to ACCA in the sum £950.00.

ACCA's regulations require ACCA to publish the Committee's finding and orders by way of a press release, as soon as practicable.
